The BIG knitted Christmas Tree

KNIT TOGETHER – BUILD COMMUNITY!

Spend time with others to knit squares.

Your squares will join those knitted by others to grow a 17ft Community Christmas Tree on display at All Saints Church, Emscote, Warwick from December 2018.

All that's needed:

- 5000 knitted squares and knitted decorations galore.
- Knitters of all ages and abilities.
- Time for the **Tree** to take root, grow and flourish.

Instructions for knitting a square:

Use Double Knit (DK) green yarn (any shade) on 6mm needles.
Cast on 40 stitches.
Garter stitch (all rows) until work measures 25cms (10ins).
Cast off.

Instructions for more experienced knitters:

Knit (or crochet) Christmas tree decorations in a range of shapes and sizes. Not too small, and no bigger than 25cms tall.
Knit wrapping paper for 'presents', to go under the tree.

More ideas for children:

Pom-poms, tassles, smaller knitted squares (eg sown together), French knitting tinsel.
