Free School Meal Entitlement

Dear Parents / Carers

As you are probably aware all infant school age children are eligible for a free hot meal in school. However, when they move to junior school this general entitlement will stop. For it to continue you are required to make an application for Free School Meals.

If your child is eligible that also means they will receive **Pupil Premium** funding. This entitles your child to free or subsidised school trips, music lessons, school uniform and help to access after school clubs. Registering children for Free School Meals and subsequently for pupil premium also enables the school to claim additional funding to improve resources for your child in school.

If you can answer yes to any of the following questions you may be eligible:

- 1) Is your joint family income is under £16,190 per year?
- 2) Are you are in receipt of any of the **benefits** listed below?
 - Income Support
 - Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
 - Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
 - Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - the guarantee element of State Pension Credit
 - Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
 - Working Tax Credit run-on
 - Universal Credit.
- 3) Are you or your partner are a member of the **Armed Forces**?

If you think you are eligible then you can either apply online at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals or speak to the school office who can make the application on your behalf.
