Easter Activity Week

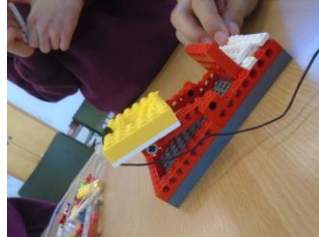
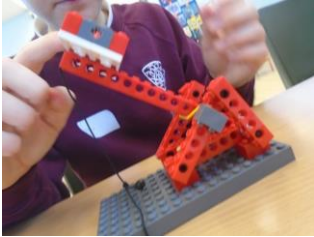
During the last week of term there will be Easter related games and competitions going on in school. Aspire would be very grateful of donations of Easter Eggs etc.
