Mrs Garrett and 3 other local teachers will be travelling to Sierra Leone on 11<sup>th</sup> Feb to visit their link schools for the first time since the Ebola crisis. Mrs Garrett, who coordinates 15 partnerships with schools in Bo, will be spending time at BDEC New Gerihun Rd Primary School, Upper (All Saints' link) and Lower (Emscote's link).

She will be taking out a project of our pupils' work around the theme: '*Where I spend my time,*' which will enable children both sides of the link to discover more about each other and learn through comparisons. She will also be leading some teacher training in Maths and Phonics, supported by materials prepared by Miss Johnson. As part of One World Link's support for the Bo schools she will be taking out reading glasses for the Bo teachers so if anyone has any **glasses cases** they don't need, still in good condition, please deliver them to the school office early next week.
